GENERAL CLEANING

Under the supervision of teachers, students participate in maintaining a clean and hygienic school environment. This forms part of our holistic education approach aimed at developing responsible and well-rounded individuals. Strict hygiene measures are observed, and students are monitored to ensure proper hand washing after cleaning activities.

HEALTH

Parents are reminded that it is unethical to send a sick child to school. Adequate medical care should be provided before resumption. The school only administers first aid and cannot give prescribed medications. Kindly inform the school if your child has any allergies to first-aid treatment.

FOOD SAFETY

Lunch boxes should be handed to pupils directly by parents at home. For safety reasons, food must not be passed to pupils through third parties such as housemaids, drivers, bike riders, uncles, or aunties, unless prior permission is granted. All food must be tasted by the bearer before it is accepted.

DRESS CODE

Approved uniforms include:

- Low-heeled black shoes with brown socks
- White canvas with white socks for sports
- Black skirts or trousers for Friday wear

Failure to comply will attract disciplinary action in line with the school's rules and regulations.

HAIR STYLE

Artificial hair extensions are strictly prohibited.

Girls: Hair must be neatly plaited or braided according to weekly guidelines.
